The Head Coach will be responsible for working with Ringette New Brunswick in the planning, organizing of the 2022-2023 Team NB. The teams and staff will be a part of RNB's High Performance Program.

To be a Coach for out Team NB you must have the following certifications:

- Open 18+ → Competition Introduction Trained

The Coach must also have all additional Ringette NB required certifications.

The ideal candidates will have a proven track record, a strong work ethic and relevant experience with ringette at major regional and/or national competitions. RNB is aware that Covid-19 has limited those opportunities over the past few seasons and will consider Community and previous HP coaching experience.

Applicants must also be a member in good standing with Ringette NB. The selected Head Coaches will work closely with athletes, other team staff members, families, Ringette NB committees and staff, event personnel, and other members of Ringette NB high performance teams. The successful candidate must possess excellent interpersonal and communication skills. This volunteer position requires extensive evening and weekend work, and travel will be required. There is an expectation that the successful candidate will prioritize their Team NB role to other coaching roles they may have.

Applicants who do not meet the minimum criteria or who do not submit a completed application package, as outlined below, will not be selected for an interview.

ESSENTIAL QUALIFICATIONS

EASTERN CANADIAN CHAMPIONSHIPS

- The head coach must be Competition-Introduction Certified or on track (prepared) to meet required certification requirements to be complete and certified before January 31, 2023. The Rest of the bench staff must be Competition-Introduction trained.
- Course to be Complete:
 - 1- Make Ethical Decision
 - 2- Coach initiation in sport
- Coaches must complete the following performance planning certification:
 - Making Headway in Sport
 - Respect in Sport for Activity Leaders
 - Coach Association of Canada Safe Sport Training
- At least three years coaching experience at/or combination of:
 - Head coach at community level
 - o RNB HP Ringette Program
 - Eastern Canadian Ringette Championships
 - Canadian Ringette Championships
- Willing and available to be a part of the RNB High Performance Program, HP Program evaluation and assessment for the 2022-2023.

ASSET QUALIFICATIONS

- Experience in a Head Coach role;
- Experience in leading a sport program; and
- Competition Development Trained or Certified in Ringette, Registered to take the Competition Development

HEAD COACH RESPONSIBILITIES

- Complete all relevant coach certification requirements;
- Follow and adhere to the RNB HP Guidelines;
- Work with Ringette NB HP program and Staff



- Support with the application, interview and selection process of Assistant Coaches and any other additional team staff;
- Plan and attend all selection and training camps, pre-tournaments and other team related events and activities;
- Serve as a positive role model, maintain the highest standards both on and off the bench;
- Uphold the Ringette NB Values and the Coach Code of Conduct;
- Work with the Team NB evaluator group on the evaluations and release of athletes through the Team NB selection process; and
- Select athletes to Team NB in collaboration with the NB HP evaluating group.

- Cover letter O Should be no longer than one page and include why you feel you are a good fit for the Team NB 2022-23, what attributes you bring and how you plan to run a successful program. If you do not currently meet coach certification requirements, mention of your plan for certification should be included.

 - One from a current/previous (within the past 3 years) coaching staff member

Interview and Selection Process

Shortlisted candidates will be offered an interview.

The interview will take place virtually and consist of the following members

- Ringette NB Executive Director
- Member selected by RNB's HP Committee



The interview will consist of a standard set of questions, as well as questions regarding the Coach's application package and any follow up questions from the Interview Committee. Prior to completing an interview, candidates will be asked to sign an Information Release Request, providing Ringette NB permission to contact their references and relevant members of the ringette and sport community. Candidates may be asked to provide additional references at the request of the Interview Panel.

The successful candidate will be required to complete the following before their appointment will be finalized and announced:

- ✓ Sign a volunteer agreement
- ✓ Complete a Criminal Record Check; and
- ✓ Show a valid Driver's License.
