RNB is looking for two (2) to three (3) new High Performance Committee members. The HP Committee consists of six (6) committee members total, plus the Chair of the committee who also represents the RNB Board of Directors.

The RNB HP Committee is mandated to provide recommendations to the RNB Board regarding the management and administration of the High Performance Ringette program in New Brunswick, and to assist in its delivery.

The HP Committee meets regularly throughout the year. While monthly meetings are typical, the committee may convene more frequently as needed during tryouts, tournaments and or events.

In addition to attending regular meetings, each HP Committee member is expected to assist with the delivery of the program, including but not limited to:

Responsibilities of the HP Committee:

- Ensuring a fair and transparent tryout process, including clear selection criteria and communication with athletes and parents.
- Developing and implementing policies to support HP athletes and teams.
- Managing logistics for HP team travel, ensuring cost-effectiveness and athlete safety.
- Coordinating apparel orders and distribution to maintain a professional team appearance.
- Securing necessary ice time for HP-related activities.
- Overseeing and coordinating participation in local and provincial tournaments.
- Providing regular updates and recommendations to the RNB Board regarding the HP program.
